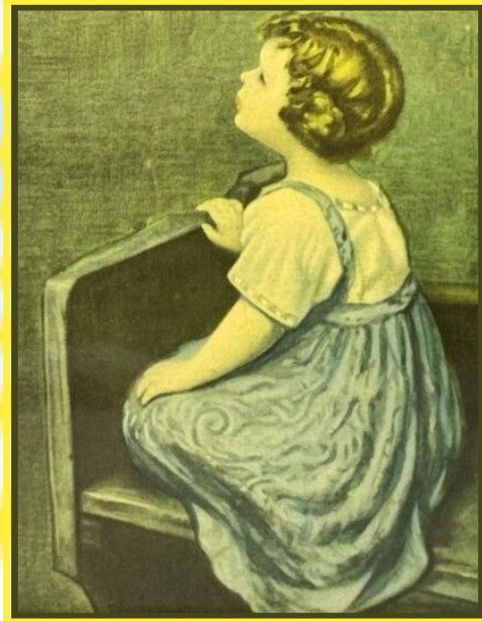


LITTLE SUNBEAM
